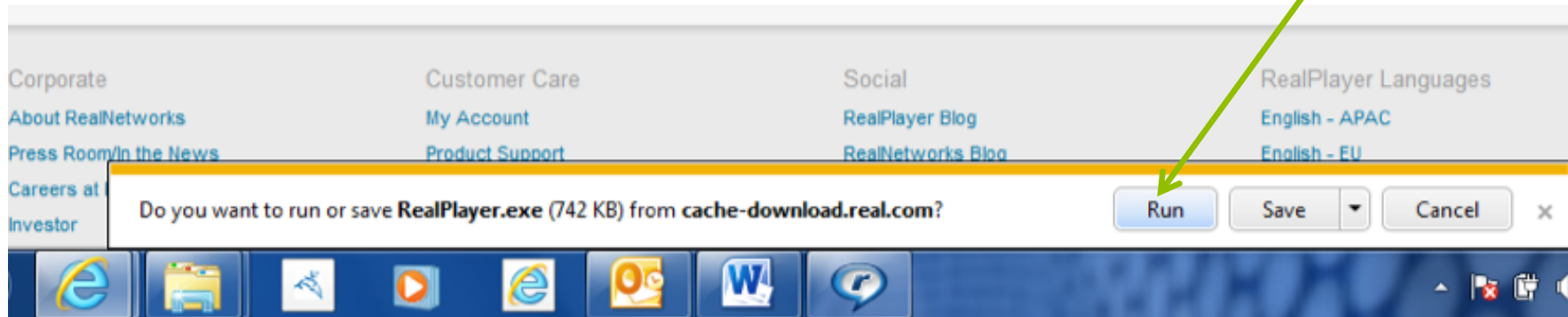
# Step 1: Download RealPlayer

- Open Internet Explorer
  - In the address bar, type in [www.real.com](http://www.real.com)
  - Click on “FREE Download”



# Step 1: Download RealPlayer (cont.)

- Click “Run” when a box pops up on your computer.



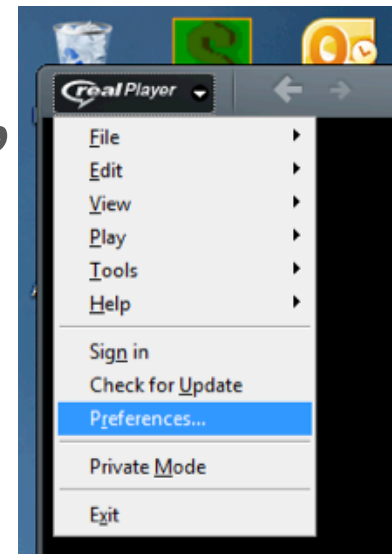
# Step 1: Download RealPlayer (cont.)

- Click “Yes” to close all internet browsers and complete download.



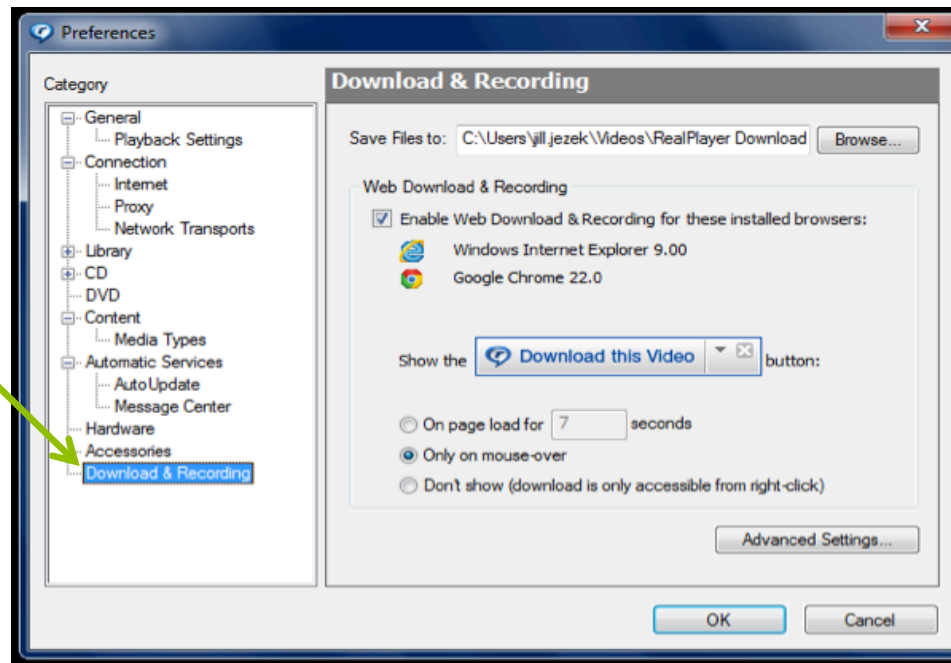
# Step 2: Change RealPlayer Settings

- 🔹 Open RealPlayer from your desktop
- 🔹 click on “RealPlayer” in the top left corner
- 🔹 select “Preferences”



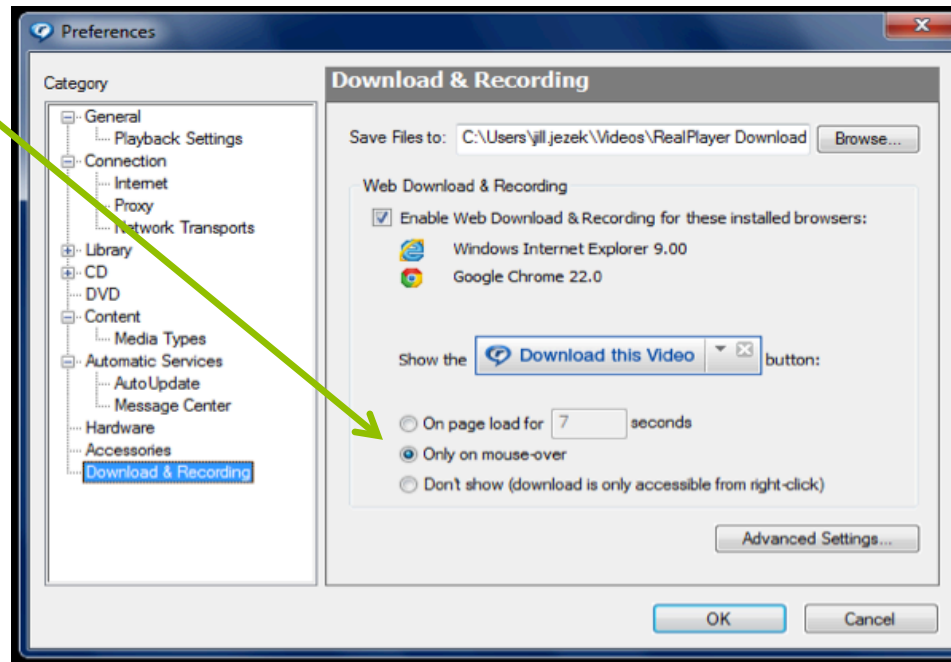
# Step 2: Change RealPlayer Settings (cont.)

- Click on **Download and Recording** on the bottom left of the window that opens.



# Step 2: Change RealPlayer Settings (cont.)

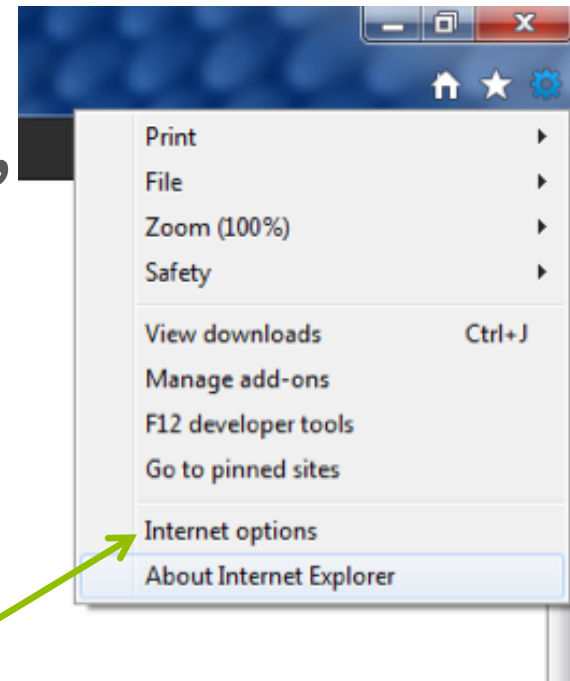
- Check “Only on Mouse Over” rather than the preset of “On page load for 7 seconds”





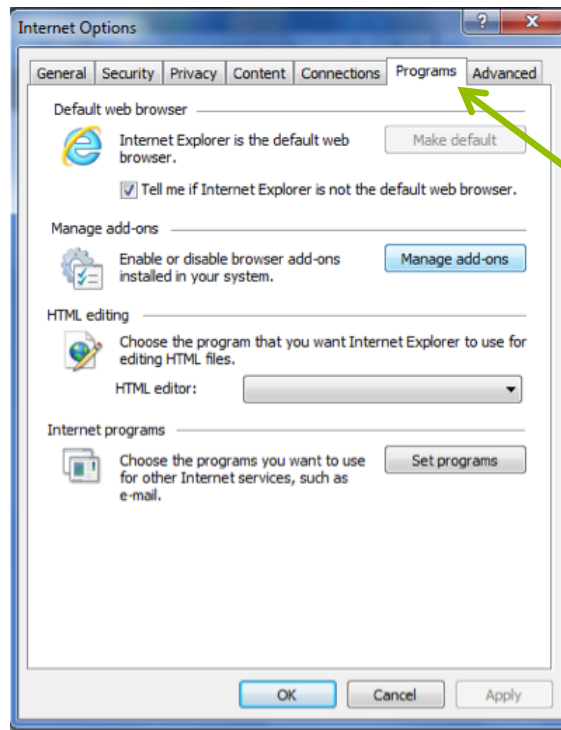
# Step 3: Change Internet Explorer Settings

- 🟢 Open Internet Explorer
  - 🟢 select “Tools”
  - 🟢 → click “Internet Options”



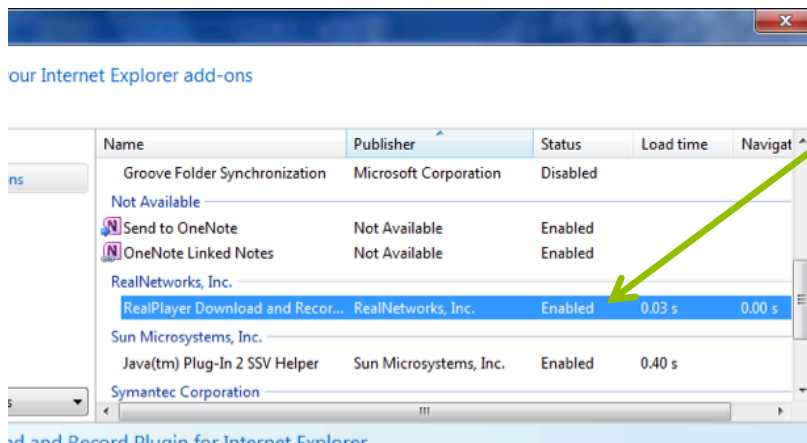
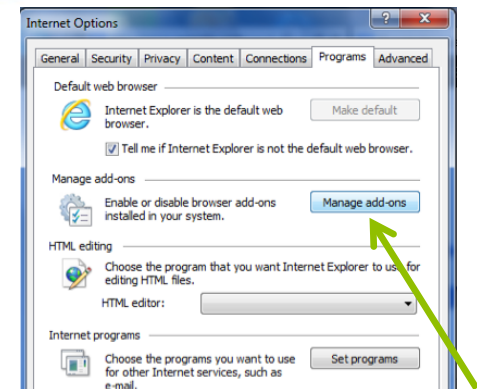
# Step 3: Change Internet Explorer Settings (cont.)

- Click on the **“Programs”** tab at the top.



# Step 3: Change Internet Explorer Settings (cont.)

- Click on “Manage Add-ons”
- Next to RealPlayer, right click on “Disabled” to “Enable”

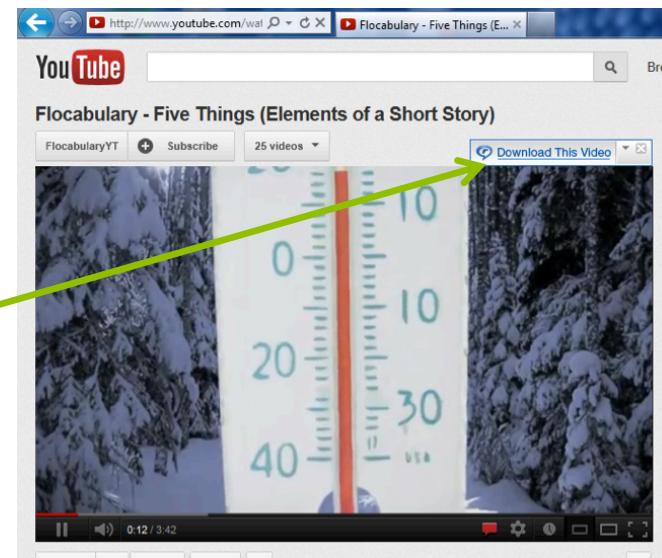


# Step 4: Download a Video from YouTube

👉 Visit [www.youtube.com](http://www.youtube.com) and play your favorite video



👉 Click on “Download This Video” on the top left of the video

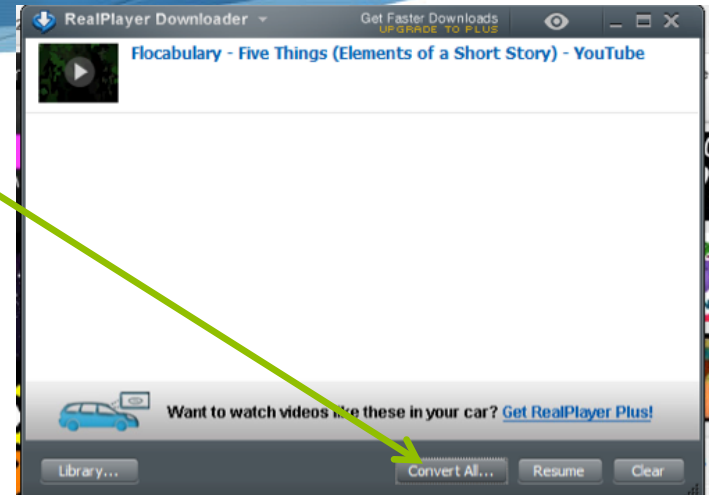

# Step 4: Download a Video from YouTube (cont.)

- When a box pops up on the screen, Click “Convert all”

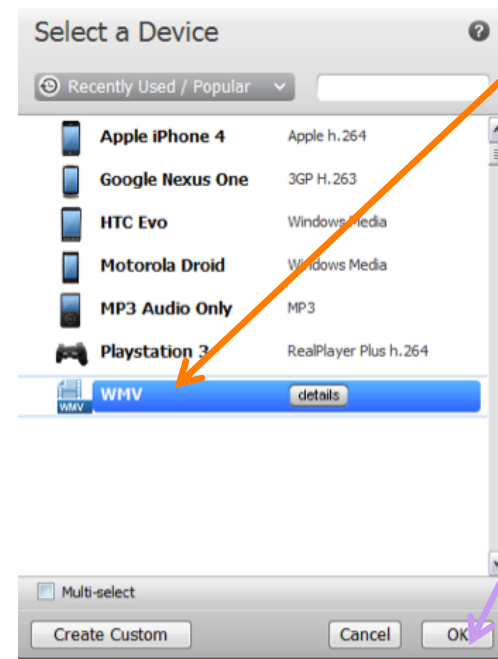
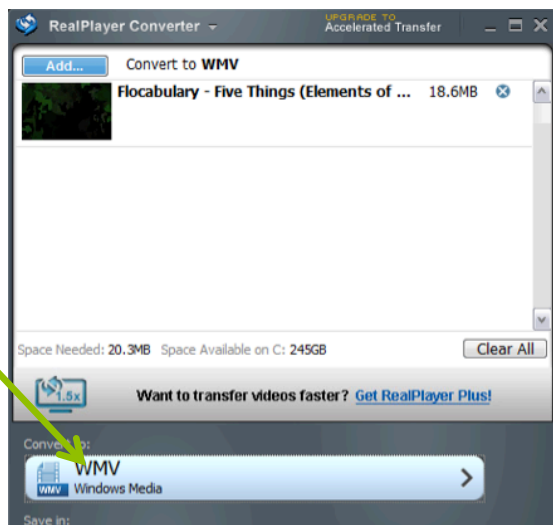


- Next, click on “Apple iPod”



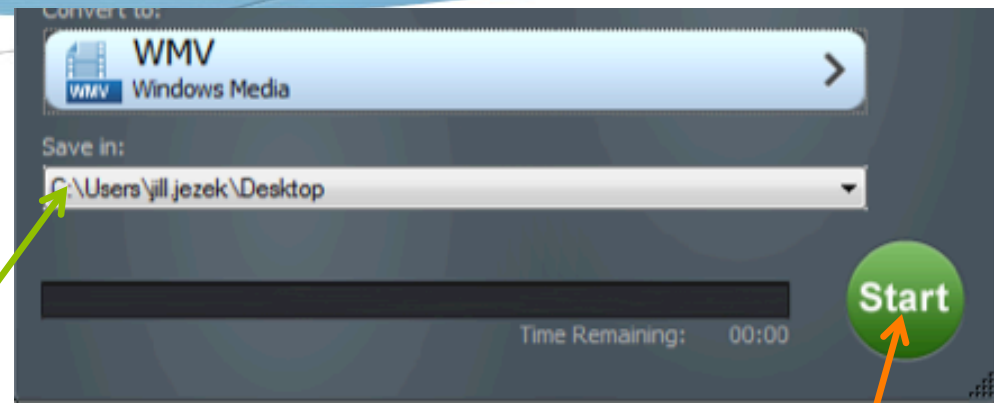
# Step 4: Download a Video from YouTube (cont.)

- 👉 Select “Portable Media Formats”
- 👉 Next, select “Video Formats-WMV”
- 👉 Finally, click “ok”



# Step 4: Download a Video from YouTube (cont.)

- Click “Save in”
- Select “Browse”



- Choose to “Desktop” and you’re ready to click “Start” to begin downloading.
